

Follow these steps to install the Universal Locking Hand Hole Cover.

- 1. Remove Universal Locking Hand Hole Cover from box.
 - a. Included will be Cover Box, Cover Plate, (2) Bolts, and Backing Bar
- 2. Check that the lock, sold by others, fits and operates in the body of the cover.
- 3. Paint the Universal Locking Hand Hole Cover with a high quality topcoat to match the color of the existing pole.
 - a. If you ordered a special paint or powder coat, bypass step #3
- 4. Remove existing hand hole cover.
 - a. Ensure that power is off to prevent injury.
- 5. Remove cover plate.
- 6. Remove lower bolt and set it aside.
- 7. Loosen upper bolt without removing it completely.
- 8. Slide backing bar into hand hole.
 - a. Insert the bottom end of the backing bar.
 - b. Slid it into the hand hole until the top section fits into the hand hole.
- 9. Raise the cover so that the backing bar is inside the hand hole and the bottom bolt hole is visible.
- 10. Insert the bottom bolt through the body of the cover and thread it into the backing bar.
 - a. Always start the bolt threads by hand to ensure no cross threading.
 - b. Using the windows in the front of the cover, make sure no wires are being pinched between the backing bar and the inside of the pole.
- 11. Tighten top and bottom bolts uniformly until the cover is seated snuggly around the hand hole opening, lip, and weld.
 - a. Still check to confirm no wires are pinched.
- 12. Install the cover plate by inserting it into the front of the cover box.
 - a. Insert the cover plate, holding the bottom of plate out 1" from the box, and $\frac{1}{2}$ " below the top of the cover box.
 - b. Slide the cover plate up, until the cover plate hooks engage, then push the bottom in.
- 13. Install the lock by holding it at a 15* angle to the left.
- 14. Secure the lock
- 15. Apply a bead of silicone or similar calking around the joint between the Universal Locking Hand Hole Cover and the pole.
